

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EU REGULATION 679/2016

The Consortium for the protection of Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil , with registered office in Florence, Viale F.lli Rosselli, 20 (hereinafter "Data Controller"), as Data Controller, to inform pursuant to art. 13 EU Regulation n. 2016/679 (hereinafter also " RGPD ") of our privacy policy and to understand how your personal information is handled when using our services and to allow you, where appropriate, to give consent to the processing of your personal data expressed and aware in the sections of the site where it is required to provide personal data.

This informative report respects and complies fully with the Recommendation no. 2/2001 that the European authorities for the protection of personal data, adopted on May 17, 2001 to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online and, in particular, the methods, timing and nature of the information that the owners of the processing must provide users when they connect to web pages, regardless of the purpose of the link. It is specified that the consent mechanisms will be evident, brief and easily understandable; if the original conditions for which consent was requested were to be changed, for example if the purpose of data processing changed, further consent will be required pursuant to European Regulation no. 679/2016.

According to the rules of the Regulations, the treatments carried out by the Consortium for the protection of Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil will be based on the principles of lawfulness, correctness, transparency, purpose limitation and conservation, data minimization, accuracy, integrity and confidentiality.

Data Controller

Purpose of the Treatment

The treatment we intend to carry out, with specific consent where necessary, has the following purposes:

- a. To allow the provision of the Services requested by you, including the collection, storage and processing of data for the purposes of the establishment and subsequent operational management (including data collection for the purpose of spontaneous applications) , technical and administrative relationship connected to the provision of the Services and the making of communications relating to the conduct of the relationship established;

- b. allow browsing and consultation of the Consortium site for the protection of the Tuscan PGI extra virgin olive oil ;
- c. respond to requests for assistance or information, which we will receive via e-mail, telephone or chat through the online application , or through the appropriate form ;
- d. fulfill legal, accounting and tax obligations;
- e. possibly to elaborate studies, research, market statistics, send informative material , commercial information , improve the service ("customer satisfaction") by e-mail or text message, and / or through the use of the telephone with operator and / or through the official pages of the Consortium for the protection of the Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil on social networks;
- f. newsletter subscription;
- g . for exclusive purposes of security and prevention of fraudulent conduct, the Controller establishes an automatic control system that involves the detection and analysis of user behavior on the site associated with the processing of Personal Data including the IP address.

2.1 Legal basis and mandatory or optional nature of data processing

The legal basis of the processing of Personal Data for the purposes referred to in the previous section is art. 6 (1) (b) of the Regulation as the data processing is necessary for the provision of the contracted services. The provision of Personal Data for these purposes is optional but failure to provide it would make it impossible to activate the required Services.

The purpose related to legal obligations is a legitimate processing of Personal Data pursuant to art. 6 (1) (c) of the Rules. Once the Personal Data have been provided, the processing may indeed be necessary to comply with legal obligations to which the Consortium for the protection of the Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil is subject .

Method of treatment

In relation to the purposes referred to in the previous point, the processing of personal data takes place in compliance with the principles of confidentiality, correctness, lawfulness and transparency, using manual, computer and telematic tools, strictly related to the purposes themselves also through the use of fax, telephone, mobile phone, e-mail or other communication techniques; personal data will be managed by implementing appropriate technical and organizational measures to guarantee a level of security appropriate to the risk pursuant to art. 32 RGPD.

Recipients of the data

Your Personal Data may be shared, for the purposes referred to in the section above, with:

- a. subjects that typically act as data controllers, that is: i) people, companies or professional firms that provide assistance and advice to the Consortium for the protection of Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil in accounting, administrative, legal and tax matters, financial and debt collection with respect to the provision of the Services; ii) subjects with whom it is necessary to interact for the provision of the Services; iii) or subjects delegated to perform technical maintenance activities (including maintenance of network equipment and electronic communications networks);

- b. subjects, bodies or authorities that are obliged to communicate their personal data in accordance with the provisions of law or orders of the authorities;
- c. persons authorized by the Consortium for the protection of the Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil to process Personal Data necessary to perform activities strictly related to the provision of the Services, who are committed to confidentiality or have an appropriate legal obligation of confidentiality, such as employees of the Consortium for the protection of Toscano PGI extra virgin olive oil;

Data retention period

The data will be processed for the entire duration of the contractual relationship and also subsequently, for the fulfillment of legal obligations and for administrative and commercial purposes.

Rights of the interested party

Pursuant to articles 7, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21 and 22 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, the interested party has the right to obtain confirmation that data concerning him is being processed and, in this case, to obtain access to the data and the following information:

The interested party has the right to obtain the indication:

- a. of the purposes of the processing;
- b. the categories of personal data in question;
- c. the recipients or the categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated, in particular for recipients of third countries or international organizations;
- d. whenever possible, the period of storage of personal data provided or, if it is not possible, the criteria used to determine this period;
- e. all available information on the origin of the data if it is not collected by the data subject;
- f. the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling.

The interested party also has:

- a. the right to obtain from the data controller the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning him without undue delay;
- b. the right to obtain from the data controller the cancellation ("right to be forgotten") of personal data concerning him without undue delay;
- c. the right to obtain treatment limitation from the data controller;
- d. the right to object at any time, for reasons connected with his particular situation, to the processing of personal data;
- e. the right to receive personal data concerning him in a structured, commonly used and automatically readable form;
- f. the right to withdraw consent at any time;
- g. the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;

h.the right to be informed of the existence of adequate safeguards, if personal data are transferred to a third country or to an international organization;

i.the right to obtain a copy of the data being processed.

To exercise these rights, you can contact the Data Controller at the contact points indicated in paragraph 1- Data Controller, by submitting a specific request by registered letter, fax and / or e-mail.

Cookies

Managers and persons in charge / authorized

The list of persons in charge of the processing and authorized / authorized to receive the treatment, constantly updated, is kept at the registered office of the Data Controller.

Cookies Policy

Cookies are small text files that are stored by a website and using the browser on a client computer's hard drive to store small amounts of site information over a period of time. Generally, there are various types of cookies; they are divided into technical cookies and profiling cookies (cookies that are used for marketing and promotional purposes).

This website uses technical and profiling cookies. The details are as follows.

Technical cookies are important above all for the functionality of the site. This includes navigation cookies and session cookies, which allow a user-friendly navigation of the site. There are also the so-called Analytics-Cookies, which collect information about the number of visitors to the site or the visitors' path to the site. The group of technical cookies also includes functional cookies, which allow the site to remember your selection (eg filters you have set or the automatic setting of the language of a website).

In addition, there are cookies that detect settings, preferences and user actions and by means of which a user profile is created, so-called profiling cookies. This serves to combine advertising with the interests of users and therefore allows targeted advertising to certain groups of users. When you open a Web page that uses these cookies, a banner is displayed that alerts the user that the site operators use cookies for marketing purposes. It also warns the user that the page may possibly allow third-party cookies.

The banner is linked to a page with detailed information (on which you are now located), where the user can refuse the storage of cookies.

The banner offers the possibility to express user consent and displays an indication that continuing with the navigation on the page automatically allows the use of cookies.

A click on detailed information does not necessarily imply consent. The banner does not disappear after a certain time, but will remain displayed until the user has consented, rejected or knowingly navigated further. We are required by law to record and memorize the user's decision, so the next time the user visits the banner will no longer appear.

You can also refuse the use of cookies in a general or selective way. If you do not wish to accept our cookies, you can reject them through the web browser. The corresponding function varies from browser to browser; the related details can be found below. Please note that failure to accept cookies may lead to functional limitations on the site.

The user can selectively opt-out the collection of data by Google Analytics by installing the appropriate component provided by Google on his browser (opt out).

The collection and use of information obtained by means of the plugin are governed by the respective privacy policies of the social networks, to which reference is made.

Consortium for the protection of Toscano PGI Extra Virgin Olive Oil complies with the provisions contained in the Code regarding the protection of personal data ("Privacy Code"), as amended by

Legislative Decree 28 May 2012, n. 69, implementing the European directive 2009/136 / EC. and in compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

You can oppose the registration of cookies on your device by configuring the browser used for navigation: if you use the site www.oliotoscanoigp.it without changing your browser settings, we assume that you will receive all the cookies used by the site and use all the functionalities.

Social Network Plugin

The site www.oliotoscanoigp.it also incorporates plugins and / or buttons for social networks, in order to allow easy sharing of content on your favorite social networks. These plugins are programmed so as not to set any cookies when accessing the page, to safeguard the privacy of users. Possibly cookies are set, if so provided by social networks, only when the user makes effective and voluntary use of the plugin. If the user browses being logged into the social network, then he has already consented to the use of cookies conveyed through this site at the time of registration to the social network.
